SAVE THE DATE

Our annual STRAWBERRY FESTIVAL will be held on Tuesday June 24 in Ruckle Park. Just so you can start drooling at the thought of a walk followed by fresh, local berries and icecream!

Sunday, June 1st

Hike – Mt. Sullivan up along trail 20, continuing on 23 and down 22. Meet at Art Spring to car pool, departing at 1:00 or at the trailhead in Burgoyne Bay to set out at 1:20.

Tuesday, June 3rd

Hike – Leslie will lead the hike. Looks like perfect conditions for our Two Summit hike to Bruce and Sullivan on Tuesday. The day will be warm and sunny so the views should be spectacular! This is one of the Club's longer hikes so I suggest you pack extra water and plan for a morning snack break in addition to lunch. Please meet at Artspring to carpool, **departing at 9:35 to allow for construction delays**, or at Drummond Park to consolidate vehicles, departing at 10:05 for the drive up Musgrave Rd. **DRIVING DIRECTIONS:** Follow Musgrave until it becomes a gravel road (at Dubois Rd.). Continue for 4km then turn right on Mt. Bruce Road. Proceed approx 100m to a parking area on the left where you will see a yellow gate (barring vehicle access to the Mill Farm trailhead).

Walk – Meet at ArtSpring for 10:00 AM departure to Baker Beach with Sheila. Departure may be a bit later to allow for construction delays. The route, mainly on trails and pathways with a couple of up hill sections, takes us through Mouat Park, along Atkins to Lower Ganges, Booth Canal, Harrison, and Baker Road. Lunch at Baker Beach. Return via Baker and Lower Ganges Road. Distance: 7km. **Ramble –** Paul Way will lead a ramble at the Blackburn Conservation area. Meet at ArtSpring to car pool and depart at 10:30 or meet at the Blackburn Conservative parking lot at 10:45. Take your lunch.

Sunday, June 8th

Hike – Ruckle Park starting at Beaver Point Hall. Meet at Art Spring to car pool departing at 1:00 or at Beaver Point Hall to set out at `1:20.

Tuesday, June 10th

Hike – Charles Kahn will lead a hike on the KDOL trail. Meet at ArtSpring to car pool, departing at 9:40, or at Drummond Park to consolidate vehicles for the drive up Musgrave Rd, departing at 10:05. Four-wheel drive/high clearance is recommended for the drive up Musgrave Road.
