Sunday, January 4th

Hike – Mt. Maxwell Rim Trail. Meet at ArtSpring departing at 12:30 or at the trailhead at the top of Seymour Heights to set out at 12:45. Trails 1, 2, 6, 4 and 3.

Tuesday, January 6th.

Hike – **N.B.** Due to bad weather, today's hike is rescheduled to Tuesday January 20th.

Walk – **N.B.** Due to bad weather, today's walk is canceled.

Sunday, January 11th

HIKE CANCELED! Steady rain forecast through the day on Sunday. Tuesday looks more promising.

Maple Mountain Blue Trail. Meet at Art Spring to car pool, departing at 10:30, or at the Vesuvius ferry terminal to walk on the 10:50 ferry. Bring a lunch. Expect to return on the 2:20 ferry or possibly 3:35. Note earlier than usual start.

Tuesday, January 13th

Hike -Larry McIntyre will lead a hike to Mt Erskine from Toynbee Rd. The trail will take us through a managed forest, then Manzanita Ridge Nature Reserve, then into Mt Erskine provincial park. Lunch will be at the top with stunning views of Vancouver Island and north towards Tent and Penelekut Islands. This is a moderate hike, approx 5.2 km and 300m elevation gain, with a steep trail at the beginning to warm us up. Meet at ArtSpring to carpool departing at 9:45 or at the trailhead on Toynbee Rd to set out at 10:00. The trailhead is just after a sharp bend 0.5 km from the start of Toynbee. Try to park on the same side of the road. *** With the recent deluge, the trail will have lots of wet and muddy sections, so wear appropriate footwear. Some sections will be quite slippery so we'll proceed cautiously through those sections.

Walk – Alison will lead a walk on Channel Ridge trails starting from the Merganser Place trail head, with lovely eastern views (weather dependent) and lunch at the "dog bench" lookout, arriving back by about 1 pm. Easy to moderate terrain. Meet at ArtSpring for a 10:00 am departure or at 10:15 am at the Merganser Place trail head (turn right off Broadwell on to Canvasback Place and take first left on to Merganser).

Reminder: Broadwell detour – from Vesuvius Bay Road, turn right onto Sunset Drive, then right at Channel Ridge Drive, and then left onto Broadwell.
